Hampsthwaite is an ancient village dating from Saxon times. Yet, in 2006 it remains a lively and vibrant place to live with a strong community spirit. We are fortunate to have a large and modern community hall, a thriving village school, two well supported churches, a village store, post office, pub and a restaurant plus other local businesses.

Today rural villages are under threat either from urban sprawl, or to become "ghost towns" devoid of any facilities.

The purpose of the Village Plan survey is to gather your views as to how YOU want Hampsthwaite to develop in the future. A large response to this survey is essential if we are to convince planners, grant aiding bodies and the local authority that WE, the residents of Hampsthwaite, care about and value our lovely village.
